Rules - Hanidcaps

- BMGA requires all players to have a USGA Index
- If a player does not have an Index established, player will follow the Callaway method which applies a one-time handicap that is based upon a player's score for the event
- Must have USGA Index established as soon as possible or at least by week 9 of the league
- If there is no handicap or trend by week 9, player plays as a o



Rules Equitable Stroke Control

- ESC = maximum per-hole score that you can turn in for handicap purposes
- Based on course handicap
- Designed to limit the effect off a blow up hole upon your handicap

Course Handicap	Maximum Score
• 0-9	Double Bogey
• 10-19	7
• 20-29	8
• 30-39	9
• 40 +	10

Wednesday Night League Only

Lost Ball

- If a ball is lost and it is certain that it is not out of bounds or in a hazard, for example left of the 10th tee, the player may drop a ball near the agreed upon most likely location that should be. The player continues play on that hole and takes a one stroke penalty.
- This is NOT in place during weekend tournaments. For weekend events and during match play, proceed under rule 27-1 as can be seen in the appendix.

Maximum Strokes

- If you have not holed out after 8 strokes, pick up and record a 9 for the hole. Apply ESC maximum when posting.

All League Play

Accidental Movement of a ball on the putting green

- When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment. The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1. This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental. NOTE: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced.

Music on course

- The BMGA voted the following policy in for all Wednesday night league play and tournament play:
 - Each foursome is asked to make their own policy
 - If a player wishes to play music, they must gain approval from all the players in the foursome

Stones in bunkers

- Any stone roughly pea-size and larger in the bunkers shall be deemed a movable obstruction and may be removed under rule 24-1.

Embedded Ball

- Relief for an embedded ball under rule 25-2 is expanded to include a ball embedded any place on the course except for in a hazard (which includes bunkers).

French Drains (aka Drain Tile)

- There are several of these on the course. This rule only applies to drains that have pea gravel showing. Many drains are older and have sod covering them, and those are excluded from this rule. If a French drain that has pea gravel on top of it interferes with your stance or swing it is deemed to be an immovable obstruction, rule 24-2 applies.

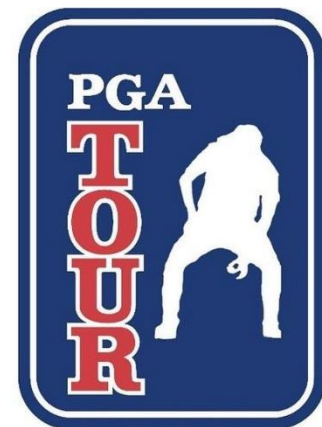

2019 USGA Rule Changes

- Embedded ball – free drop except from bunker/penalty area
- Ball hits equipment or himself – no penalty
- Accidental touching of sand – no testing
- Ball/Stance on wrong green – free drop
- Putting with the flag stick in
- Unplayable in a bunker
 - New Option to drop outside the bunker (2 Strokes)
- Double Hit – no penalty
- 3 Minute search time
- Dropping – knee height, choose your position

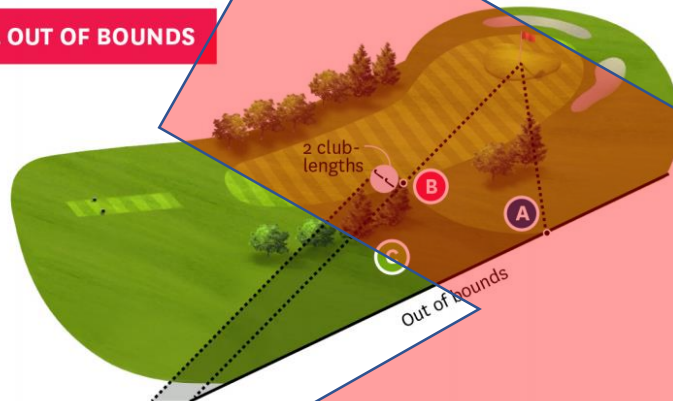


2019 USGA Rule Changes – Local Rules

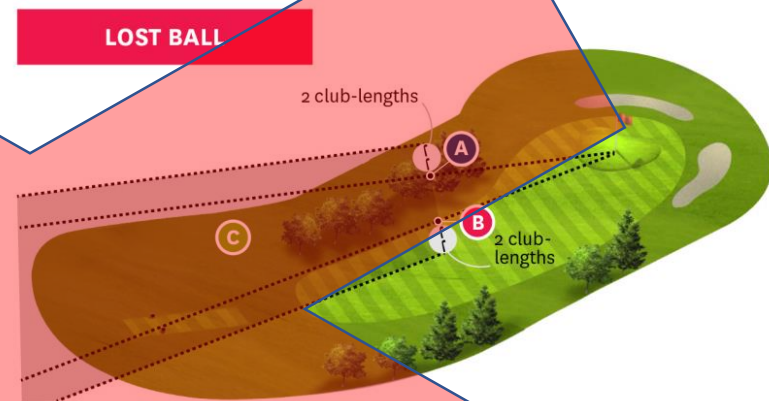
GOLF'S NEW RULES: STROKE AND DISTANCE

A new Local Rule provides an alternative to stroke-and-distance relief for a ball that is lost outside a penalty area or out of bounds, effective January 1, 2019.

BALL OUT OF BOUNDS



LOST BALL



If the Local Rule is in effect, you can still take stroke-and-distance relief, but you now have the following additional option that comes with a penalty of two strokes:

A DETERMINE SPOT where your ball went out of bounds (left diagram) or is likely to be lost (right diagram).

B FIND NEAREST FAIRWAY EDGE no closer to the hole.

C DROP YOUR BALL IN SHADED AREA as defined on one side by a line from the hole through point A and on the other side by a line from the hole through point B, and not nearer the hole. The relief area is extended on both sides by two club-lengths.

This Local Rule is not intended for higher levels of play, such as professional or elite amateur level competitions.

Hole in 1 Club
